### SUPPLY LIST – GRADE 2

Dear Families,

Welcome to grade two! At the time of registration, you pre- paid a fee to contribute to classroom supplies. This is greatly appreciated, as it allows for the uniformity of school supplies. It also facilitates the centre-based learning approach that we implement in the primary grades. Central purchasing of supplies ensures that the proper materials are available for the children to use. These funds will purchase basic supplies such as pencils, crayons, markers, glue sticks, scrapbooks etc.

There are some personal supplies that still need to be provided by families. Please bring in the following supplies on the first day of school:

1. 2 boxes of facial tissues
2. A knapsack or school bag large enough for lunch kit & other essentials (**not sports equipment size and must be able to be hung on a hook**).
3. Inside shoes  
These should be proper running shoes with short laces, or Velcro tabs, as they will also be used for gym class. **Please make sure your child can tie his/her laces independently.** (Velcro is recommended until the children are able to tie their laces independently.)
4. A **complete** change of clothing, including 2 pairs of socks, pants, shirt, underwear. All items must be labeled with names. This set of clothing will remain at school all year to be available for “emergency” situations. This set does not have to be a school uniform. PLEASE PUT ITEMS IN A LARGE ZIPPED PLASTIC BAG WITH YOUR CHILD’S NAME ON IT.
5. 1-Old Large sized t-shirt to use as a smock or during art activities. Please note, this t-shirt will get stains on it, and will be used to protect your child’s uniform during art classes.

**All uniforms and other clothing MUST be clearly marked so that lost items can be easily returned.**
